This feature defaults to a simplified patient and provider menu, which only includes the essentials. To view the full patient and provider menu (the current DreamStation menu), you simply need to set Advanced Menus to "ON" from the Provider mode.

Note: All data is available in EncoreAnywhere and Care Orchestrator no matter which menu is selected.

All DreamStation devices, excluding DreamStation Go, have the Advanced Menus defaulted to "OFF" when they leave the factory.






