- rapid collection of data (60 days from start)



Methods

Electronic questionnaire

Forms of contact

- facebook communication
- e-mail contacting of respondents

Total number of respondents

• 2375 mothers with children older than one year




Validation/verification of data

cooperation with a biostatistician

- Written responses were required of respondents
 - eliminated robotically filled questionnaires
- Email addresses of respondents obtained
 - direct contact with respondents
- Correlation of data with obstetric statistics from 2016 (spontaneous births, forceps/VE, cesarean sections)

Distribution of respondents from individual Czech regions








Average age of mothers

29.9 years




Education levels





Beginning of lactation






Children fully breastfed up to 6 months
